



Gainesville Regional Transit System (RTS) Title VI Notice to the Public

RTS operates its transit services without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, marital status, age or disability in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and its amendments.

RTS Title VI Policy Statement

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 states:

"No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance."

RTS is committed to complying with the requirements of Title VI in all of its federally funded programs and activities.

Making a Title VI Complaint

Any person who believes that he or she or any specific class of persons has been subjected to discrimination that is prohibited by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, its amendments and related statutes, by the Gainesville Regional Transit System (RTS) in its role of planning and programming of federal funds, may submit a written complaint. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with RTS within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
