Vehicle Service Attendant \$11.67 – \$14.43* per hour. Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, and one year experience in automotive vehicle or heavy equipment repair and servicing, preferably in a public works or utility fleet, or an equivalent combination of education and experience which provide the required knowledge, skills and ability.

Fleet Mechanic I \$15.95 – \$19.72* per hour. Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, supplemented by appropriate technical courses, and three years experience in automotive, vehicle or heavy equipment repair and servicing, preferably in a public works or utility fleet, or an equivalent combination of education and experience which provide the required knowledge, skills and ability.

Fleet Mechanic II \$18.20 – \$22.47* per hour. Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, supplemented by appropriate technical courses preferably including training by vehicle manufacturers' and/or accredited vocational-technical institution, and five years experience as a diesel mechanic, preferably in a public works or fleet environment, or an equivalent combination of training and experience which provide the required knowledge, skills and ability.

Fleet Mechanic Lead \$20.09 – \$24.80* per hour. Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, and six years experience as a mobile equipment mechanic, including two years experience supervising mobile equipment mechanics, preferably with a public works or utility fleet, or an equivalent combination of education and experience which provide the required knowledge, skills and ability.

Frequently Asked Questions

What happens after I apply?

Your application/resume will be reviewed. If it is determined that your qualifications meet ours, you may be contacted for testing and/or an interview.

How long does it take before I know if I'll be interviewed?

Normally, two weeks. However, it could be two additional weeks, depending on the number of applicants there are.

What happens after the interview?

If you are recommended for hire, a complete background investigation will be conducted, which includes a thorough criminal and driving history background check. The time from interview to hire is normally three to four weeks.

What hours or shifts are available?

We operate three shifts providing 24-hour service Monday through Friday and Saturday service from 7:00 p.m. to 3:30 a.m. New employees can expect to work later shifts.
